The Baden region covers a distance of over 400 km from the Bodensee in the south up to Tauberfranken and is divided into nine wine regions. Numerous varieties of grape flourish on an area of 15,000 hectares which present interesting sensory differences due to the different soil types and varying geographical features. Baden is the warmest German wine-growing area as a light Mediterranean breeze reaches the lower Rhine valley from southern France. The region is also particularly famous for its pinots.

facts and figures

Vineyard area: 15,000 ha, made up of 56 % white wine

Main grape-varieties: Spätburgunder, Müller-Thurgau, Grauburgunder, Weissburgunder, Riesling

Well-known locations: Heidelberg, Freiburg, Baden-Baden

Soil: A great diversity of soils, which varies significantly between the nine regions in Baden.


Baron von Maydell – History

“Synergy of quality and tradition” – Baron Peter von Maydell, inspired by Baden and the 800-year-plus family tradition, created this proud, noble wine. The crest of German nobility as a sign seals the excellent quality of this wine. Vinification, made together with the Bimmerle winery, has repeatedly been awarded national prizes as well as other national and international awards. The winery, with its top products, is among the “elite of German wines.”*

Baron Peter von Maydell comes from German Uradel. His forefathers lived from agriculture for over 800 years. That binds.






